COMMUNITY SERVICE AWARDS

Each year the Parish Council presents Community Service Awards to residents or workers in the Parish, who have been nominated for giving outstanding service to the Community. There are two levels of award for adults and for those under eighteen years of age and there is no restriction on the number that can be awarded each year. Nominations for the award may be made by local parishioners and forwarded to the Parish Clerk before March 31st. with brief supporting information about the reasons the person is being nominated. Those receiving an award will receive a plaque and a printed certificate and these will be presented at the Annual Parish Meeting held in May.

Elected Councillors can only be nominated for community activity which is not related to their responsibilities as a Councillor.

SMARTWATER

The Council works in partnership with the Police and Smartwater to try and create a crime free community and every resident is entitled to a free pack of Smartwater for use in their home to help protect their valuables.
