Each year the Parish Council has to provide Shropshire Council with information on the following issues:

1. Future Community Infra-structure Development Projects.

These are projects that can be funded from money raised by a levy placed on new housing development in the parish and which is shared between the Parish Council and Shropshire Council.

2. Community Road Safety Concerns.

This is an opportunity to highlight and prioritise all aspects of road safety that the public wish to see addressed and covers items such as speed control, footpath and road maintenance, road signs, etc.

You may recall that last year there was a proposal for the construction of fifty houses on land opposite Rapra and it is likely the planning application will be sent to Shropshire Council before the date of this meeting. The Parish Council will be stressing the need for the construction of a roundabout on the A53 at the junction with the entrance to the new estate and also to have a parking and bus 'pick up' area at the far end of the new estate.

Not only will the roundabout make access safer to the new estate and Rapra but will also be a much needed curb on the speed of traffic entering the village from the Shrewsbury direction. The parking and bus area would have an access path to the school and will ease the amount of traffic using Church Street and White Lodge Park estate.

Parish Council Members are keen to receive additional comments from members of the community and invite you to attend the meeting advertised above and raise your concerns and suggestions.
